DO you want a car that rocks really rocks? Then you want one of these. This is the Adam Rocks – courtesy of Vauxhall.

It's a hot hatch, a cool customer and the best of British.

It's a diddy hatchback but it is fully loaded with every luxury and has a quality feel way above its price tag.

The Air comes with an awesome canvas roof – and plenty of headroom – 93 million miles to be precise.

A rockin' interior has de rigueur infotainment centre, all touch screen and tablet-like.

There are not only heated seats but a heated steering wheel; it's not often you get that on a little car. Then there's climate control and cruise.

Overall the interior is funky, groovin', young and trendy. At the sharp end there

is a chunky steering wheel, sporty bucket seats and it is snug and cosy in the back. Bright blue livery, in this case, is resplendent and eye-catching and you even get a Union Flag...patriotic!

Adam is powered by a tiny engine, a one litre with only three cylinders. But it has a turbocharger so it absolutely flies.

It romps through the Dales and is a glorious hill climber, but it remains nice and economical, cruises well on the motorway and is at home round town.

Sharp steering, firm suspension and big alloys make it a hoot to drive down the twisty stuff. It gets you grinning from ear to ear.
